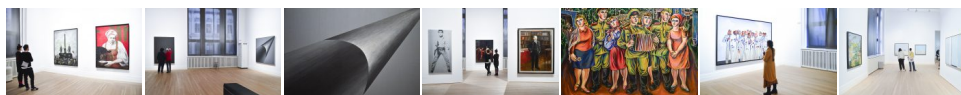

“The Cool and the Cold”. Cold War painting at Gropius Bau

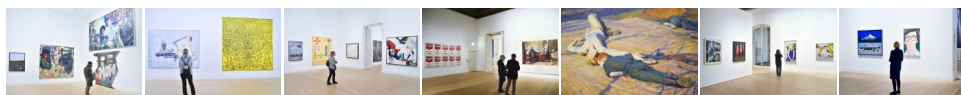


Thirty years after the collapse of the Soviet Union, the **Gropius Bau** presents *The Cool and the Cold: Painting in the United States and the USSR 1960–1990*, a major group exhibition bringing together works from the **Ludwig Collection** on loan from six international museums. Until January 9, 2022.

Peter and Irene Ludwig were among the first collectors to acquire art by both American and Soviet artists simultaneously. The exhibition presents a critical juxtaposition of works from both sides of the East-West conflict, examining how artists responded during the Cold War to the political and aesthetic questions of their time and negotiated the ideas of individual and social freedom.



The selection includes approximately 125 works by more than 80 artists, including **Andy Warhol, Jasper Johns, Roy Lichtenstein, Ilya Kabakov, Erik Bulatov, Jo Baer, Lee Lozano, Jackson Pollock, Helen Frankenthaler, Viktor Pivovarov, Natalya Nesterova** and **Ivan Ćukjov**.
